Climate Change

Scientific consensus is that human induced climate change is happening – and alpine systems will feel it faster and more drastically.



Habitat Changes

Shorter green-up windows and shrinking alpine meadows will make foraging more difficult for mountain goats.



Weather Response

Mountain goats are specifically adapted to cold temperatures. Too much warmth will heat stress, change their behavior, and alter habitat selection



Species interactions

Many parasites and predators are currently limited by the extreme cold of alpine winters. More and different species will be introduced to mountain goat habitats.



Management Implications

Critical habitat must be protected from resource extraction and development, requiring jurisdictional cooperation. We will need to incorporate new technologies and monitoring methods.
